

Bible Read-a-Thon (10-12 June)

The **Bible Read-a-Thon** we did on 10 – 12 June, as part of *Revive Our Hearts SA's* sixth birthday celebration was a huge project that accomplished far more than we ever could have hoped. We read the entire **Bible** in **72 hours** on the *Zoom* platform with the help of all our *ROH* international friends. We stand in awe of the extent of the project that achieved far more than we thought or dreamed possible. We would like to thank everyone that was involved.

Approximately 280 people in 26 different languages across 17 countries read the Bible.



There were people consistently logged onto the call to hear the reading of the Word with a maximum of 25 people online at any single time. There were a group of 29 ladies who read parts of the Bible in their own time during the weekend. Also, a congregation from George, South Africa, read 1 and 2 Kings during their Sunday morning service.

The event ended with the highlight of **60 people**, across different countries, **reading The Lord's Prayer aloud**, each in their own language.

Focus Areas of Revive Our Hearts SA

1. Development of Revive Our Heart USA Resources

1.1 Seeking Him Broadcast Groups

The <u>Seeking Him podcasts</u> continue to be distributed on weekdays in **English**, and we have translations available for voice recordings in **Afrikaans** and **Tsonga**. The participants in the *WhatsApp* groups then share these recordings with their respective contacts. While we are unsure of the exact extent of the distribution network, we are aware of the reach that has been reported to us.

Additionally, the <u>Afrikaans</u> and <u>Tsonga</u> voice messages, along with the corresponding transcriptions in Afrikaans, are uploaded daily on our website. Our website is linked to the international page of the *ROH US* website.

We are actively seeking individuals who can translate and distribute the podcasts into other indigenous national languages. This is a prayerful endeavour as we aim to expand the accessibility of our content to a broader audience.



2. Development of New Revive Our Hearts SA resources

2.1 Radio

The weekly radio program presented by Retha de Villiers on *Caledon FM*, concluded at the end of December 2022. Jan Greyling, the announcer responsible for broadcasting the program, transitioned to a new job, resulting in the discontinuation of his program. It started off as a message of encouragement during the Covid pandemic. The content of the program is adapted and recorded as *"Lewensaadjies"* for YouTube.

2.3 Magazines

2.2 YouTube

No *YouTube* recordings have been conducted since the beginning of 2023. After the radio broadcasts came to an end, Retha recognized the need to devote more time to her personal spiritual journey and seek guidance from the Lord before resuming public sharing and ministry.

3. Equipping and Supporting Women Leaders



3.1 Ambassadors' Program

Supporting leaders has always been a key priority for *ROH*, which is why the *Ambassadors' Program* was introduced. In South Africa, we share this value, but in the past seven years, our focus has predominantly been on ministry growth, resulting in the development and support of leaders occasionally taking a backseat.

However, with the new structure in place, where Wilmie van Tonder, our Ambassador, assumes responsibility for all the *Regional Ministry Partners (RMP)*, we are confident that we will make significant strides in reaching out to leaders and providing the support they need. This change marks a significant step forward in our commitment to nurturing and empowering leaders within the ministry.

3.1.1 Wilmie van Tonder (ROH Ambassador in George)

As *ROH SA* Ambassador, Wilmie van Tonder, based in George, is responsible for sending the daily *Seeking Him* messages as well as the weekly *Living Seeds* to a *WhatsApp* group with an ever-growing membership, recently exceeding

100 ladies. She is also the *ROH* book distribution centre for the Southern Cape region.

She held gatherings with 9 leaders from 7 different ministries and churches.

Another valuable partner since 2018 is Magda Burger from *Liberty Christian Church* who recently completed a Bible study group through *True Woman 101,* managing to reach the hearts of several broken women.

New relationships are being fostered with two missionaries. One is working on her second *ROH* Bible study in Madagascar, this time in French. The other one is trusting God for another season to formally minister to women in Vietnam. It is heartening to see how *ROH* materials continue to reach women, both in South Africa and beyond.

Recently Wilmie has connected with young missionaries from Germany and Austria, having a passion for girls and women in crisis (prostitutes, the poor, etc.), as well as the deaf community. Through this budding relationship they have been introduced to the locally available *ROH* resources, as well as the German *ROH* material which they can share with friends and family back home.

We are excited about the significant impact Wilmie as ROH Ambassador has had, and continues to have, on the lives of women in our region.

3.2 Leader Support

In September, Jannie and Retha paid a visit to Sindy Naudé in Koekenaap who was identified as a possible RMP. They got to know her better and gave her some resources.

True Girl South Africa, founded by Annalien Prinsloo, was launched under the mentorship of Revive Our Hearts SA.

3.3 ROH SA Team

In recent developments ROH USA and Life Action Ministries became to separate ministries and ROH USA started conducting weekly Chapel sessions. All ROH teams worldwide have been invited to participate through live streaming. They have initiated the study of Seeking Him to reinforce the fundamental values of ROH.

However, due to the time difference and frequent power outages, it has become challenging for our team to watch the sessions regularly. To address this, Marcia Loots has taken the initiative to create a weekly summary and share it with all ROH SA team members via WhatsApp. This ensures that everyone remains informed and connected.



Seek Time

The Revive Our Hearts SA team spent the first two days of April 2022 seeking God for direction and instruction for the ministry. On this occasion, we read from Isaiah 44-45.

After personal solitary time with the Lord, feedback

was shared. It was encouraging, as always, to see how God answered each person from His Word, but especially encouraging to see how God brought everything together through individually answered prayers.

The consent was that no new canals need to be dug at present, but that the existing canals need to be widened, deepened and lengthened.

Practically this means that more women need to be reached with the truth from His Word through existing channels such as the WhatsApp groups, Bible studies and social media. This needs to be done through determined focus on more leaders and different generations.

4. Equipping Women of all Generations and Cultures

4.1 Table Talks (George, Western Cape)

A Vivid Life partnered with Revive Our Hearts South Africa, at an event called, Table Talks, in George, South Africa.

ROH SA was privileged to be the focus. Retha de Villiers (main speaker), spoke on Psalm 107 and the prisons we find ourselves in. She ministered to weary hearts and invited the ladies to call on God to save them and lead them away from trouble. Maureen Beetge (George Baptist Church), Dawn Whitehead (Hope Church) and Marli Volschenk, (missionary from Madagascar), shared their testimonies on how they practically use ROH material to encourage women to freedom, fullness and fruitfulness in Christ. Wilmie van Tonder (Ambassador for ROH, Southern Cape) concluded the program with an invitation to the ladies to take up the role of mentoring and discipleship as outlined in Titus 2.





We are thankful to Suria Scholtz (A Vivid Life) for arranging the event and choosing to partner with ROH SA. She has been a long term friend and volunteer and through her passion for women's ministry the message of ROH has reached many women in George.

4.2 Women's morning (Cullinan, Gauteng)



Jivannadi Missions

Larise Fourie: There were many testimonies of God's grace at this conference, but I will share only two.

A newlywed husband showed his commitment to his wife when he drove her to the conference and sacrificed the next six hours of his time, caring for his four month old baby in the reception of Jivannadi

Mission, so that his wife could attend the conference.

We were delighted that a Hindu lady attended the conference at the invitation of her friend. She was deeply touched by the testimony of cancer patient Colleen Chao, as she herself has also been in and out of the hospital with breast cancer.

4.5 Mukhanyo Bible School

As an academic institution with a missional heart *Mukhanyo*, amongst other things, holds day conferences to minister to the spiritual needs of people in local churches and the community. On Saturday, 26 March 2022, a ladies' conference was held at the KwaMhlanga campus with the theme "Biblical Womanhood". Corné Loots, from *Revive our Hearts South Africa*, was the main speaker. The theme she selected was "A woman's identity in God." She explained that we all come from different backgrounds and even language groups. The audience was challenged to be cautious with whom or what they identified.





Corné testified:

Preparing for this conference was a special journey to me. The Father helped me confirm my own identity in Him and so the day was a testimony of myself. More so, it excited me about my own role – to be a true Naomi for the Ruth generation. My wonderful young translator, Rebecca, was a personification of this fresh calling.

Paarl, Western Cape

Trudie Boshoff, previously on the *ROH SA* team, relocated to the Paarl and started a women's ministry in her new congregation. She wrote the following about the Bible studies she leads:

We are 35 ladies, in different seasons of life and from different backgrounds, gathering for a

weekly Bible study. I love witnessing how God is working in every heart. We started with "My Hartsversugtinge" (Afrikaans translation of Nancy De Moss Wolgemuth's My Personal Petitions). The book and the Spirit-filled videos by Nancy are highly recommended. It is the





ideal resource for any unsure, "first time" leader wishing to see revival in her community.

Our other Bible study group of 50 women has completed the exceptional Afrikaans Bible study course and video series "Vrou ... deur God geskep" (Woman created by God). There were challenging questions on topics related to our position as women in relationship with the Lord; submission; sexual intimacy; our role in disciplining our children; the significance in passing the baton of truth and divine values to the next generation; and many more. It was a fantastic series ensuring a generation of strong women are rooted in the right foundation, so everything else we do can flow from a sacred place. Our group truly experienced significant breakthroughs and liberation in various areas, and the name of the Lord was glorified.

Madagascar

Marlee Volschenk:

In 2015, after 15 years in the Madagascar mission field, I had a deep desire for spiritual food and fellowship with other believers. Friends in South Africa encouraged me to become part of one of the *Women at Work* online Bible studies. It was a wonderful experience and I felt how the Word and fellowship flowed into the fibre of my womanhood. It was so refreshing to gather around the Word with other women hungry for spiritual growth. One study led to another, and I was soon challenged to mentor and lead other online studies.

My Malagasy English speaking friends, Vola and Hasina, bubbled with excitement when I returned from South Africa with *ROH's* Bible study books. We started a unique Bible study where I translated video sessions for these ladies. Every gathering is so special and fulfilling. I cannot praise God enough for the *ROH* material and the *Women at Work* Bible studies!

Pure Hope

Pure Hope School is an educational institution for underprivileged children. Roughly four years ago a girls' group was started by two former members of the ROH SA team, namely Marinda Prinsloo and Leanie de Korte.

Leanie testifies:

We gather once a week around the Word. We share, serve and pray for each other. We often take on hard subjects and use *Revive Our Hearts* and *True Girl* resources in an attempt to discover the truth as taught in the Word. Our conversations are honest and open, no topic is too tough to tackle. Each person's opinion is heard, but then we dig deep to come to the only Truth. The Truth that stands above cultural ways and traditions. Our prayer is to send these girls into the world to bring hope, be hope and live hope.

Other Bible Study Groups

Some of our team members are also involved in various other groups where *ROH's* material is being used, including in Vastfontein and Moreletapark (Gauteng), Harrismith, and a group of women workers in a paint factory in Bloemfontein (Free State).


